X : Row currently applies to this state or country

X¹: CDFA's approach to external quarantines is to address each pest separately, but this ends up approaching a full Exterior Quarantine when considered as a whole (5 forest pests + IFA)

X²: Minnesota has a full external quarantine on all hardwood species, but not softwood/coniferous

X³: State of Oregon prohibits untreated firewood from all sources outside of the Pacific Northwest (OR, ID, WA)

X⁴: State of Ohio's TCD area external quarantine *may or may not* apply to all firewood regardless of tree species, *need further clarification*

X⁴: State of Wisconsin's TCD area external quarantine applies to all firewood regardless of tree species
